## HISTORIC CASES

1971: Baker v. Nelson

The first case in the nation seeking same-sex marriage.

2016: Outfront MN v. Johnson Piper

This case won Medicaid coverage for transition-related surgeries.

**2020:** Esparza et al. v. Nobles County
This case disrupted the deportation pipeline.

### HISTORIC CASES CONTINU



2020: NAACP v. MN Secretary of State

This case expanded ballot access during the pandemic.

2021: Rodriguez v. Riley

Won a \$590,000 settlement for Kelvin Francisco Rodriguez and police reforms in the city of Worthington.
