## LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES | 2019

The American Civil Liberties Union of Minnesota has been defending and advancing civil liberties in our state for 67 years.

### CRIMINAL JUSTICE

#### **Bail Reform, HF 741/SF 878 (Support)**

Limits cash bail.

#### **Cap on Probation, HF 689/SF 1606 (Support)**

Would cap probation at five years.

#### **Fines and Fees, HF 1060/SF 1375; HF 1061/SF 1376 (Support)**

Reduces or waives traffic and criminal fines and fees for those who can least afford them. Makes it harder to suspend driver's licenses for minor reasons.

#### **Forfeiture Reform, HF 1971/SF 2155 (Support)**

Replaces civil forfeiture with criminal forfeiture and gives proceeds to the state general fund to eliminate incentives to "police for profit."

#### **Probation Guidelines, HF 707/SF 173 (Support)**

Adds probation to sentencing guidelines.

### FREE SPEECH AND TECHNOLOGY

#### **Net neutrality, HF 136/SF 317 (Support)**

### IMMIGRANT RIGHTS

#### **Immigrant Driver's Licenses, HF 1500 (Support)**

#### **Post-Conviction Relief, HF 739/SF 2495 (Support)**

Extends the time period for post-conviction relief for people who are in removal proceedings, detained or face likely deportation.

### LGBTQ RIGHTS

#### **CONVERSION THERAPY BAN, HF 12/SF 83 (Support)**

Prohibits conversion therapy for minors.

### REPRODUCTIVE FREEDOM

#### **20-Week Abortion Ban, SF 1609/HF 1312 (Oppose)**

#### **Required Viewing of Ultrasound, SF 1168/HF 1108 (Oppose)**

### SURVEILLANCE, PRIVACY & TECH

#### **Drone Privacy, HF 1236/SF 1430 (Support)**

Requires the government to obtain a search warrant before using drones for surveillance.

#### **Cell Phone Location Tracking, HF 631/SF 1263 (Support)**

Requires transparency and reporting for cell phone location tracking.

#### **Employee Social Media Privacy, HF 1196/SF 1432 (Support)**

Prohibits employers from forcing employees in most circumstances to provide access to personal social media accounts and web pages.

#### **Electronic Communications Privacy, HF 1997/SF 1431 (Support)**

### VOTING RIGHTS

#### **Restoration HF 40/SF 856 (Support)**

Restores the right to vote for 53,000 people with felony convictions who are living in the community.

#### **Voter Assistance HF 94/SF 586 (Support)**

Allows volunteers to assist more people in voting.

#### **Provisional Ballots SF 1109 (Oppose)**

Curtails voting rights by requiring provisional ballots where eligibility is challenged.
