Introducing the Liberty Awards

In 1996, the ACLU of Minnesota created the Earl Larson Award to honor members of the legal community who have demonstrated a lifelong commitment to justice and civil liberties. Today the Earl Larson Award remains the premier recognition of a life spent in service to these principles.

Last year we expanded our awards program by adding the Changemaker Award, honoring an individual or organization who has worked closely with ACLU-MN to protect civil liberties in Minnesota.

As the struggle for justice and equality grows ever more urgent, we have recognized the need to honor even more of the activists, organizations and community members who are at the forefront of this fight.

That's why, in 2020, we will introduce the ACLU-MN **Liberty Awards (formerly the Earl Larson Awards).**

Along with the new event name, we have also added one more award. The Torchbearer Award will honor an individual or group who acted bravely to protect and promote civil liberties in Minnesota in 2019. For the first time ever, we are opening nominations for this particular award to the general public.

Five levels of sponsorship are available for the Liberty Awards, including three Presenting Sponsorships. In addition to receiving the full range of sponsorship benefits, each presenting sponsor will be named as the sole sponsor of one of our three awards.
