

Strategic Planning Committee Charter

The Strategic Planning Committee will oversee the strategic planning process necessary to develop a strategic plan for the ACLU of Minnesota. The process will involve:

- Identifying, interviewing and hiring a facilitator to help direct the strategic process, after consulting with the Executive Director about an appropriate budget and objectives for the facilitator;
- Planning a process to engage appropriate stakeholders in the strategic planning process; including Union and Foundation Board members, the Executive Director, staff, and community stakeholders;
- Reviewing the existing ACLU of Minnesota strategic plan and proposals to revise or add to it as part of the process and in consultation with the stakeholders identified above;
- Drafting a new strategic plan for the ACLU of Minnesota to be submitted to the Union and Foundation Boards for approval;
- Continuing to monitor and report on implementation of the strategic plan after it is adopted.
